Accessing FHS PACS, EPIC & Powerscribe

EPIC

Make sure you have the Citrix plug-in downloaded on your computer prior to trying to access this portal. The following link allows you to download the web plug in.

User your FHS credentials to log in on the initial page. Make sure you select Tacoma-WA as the domain.




Then select the Epic folder then the Epic FHS Hyperspace Icon. If you do not have EPIC access the EPIC folder will not appear.

Powerscribe

You can only access FHS Powerscribe on FHS workstations/computers. At this time since they still are using Powerscribe 5.0 there is not a portal. Once they upgrade to 360 I will find out if they are going to utilize the portal for radiologists.
