Accessing MHS PACS, EPIC & Powerscribe

EPIC

To access EPIC you will go to https://myportal.multicare.org.

Below are steps to install the Citrix receiver on your computer if you do not have it already.

Install Citrix on your Computer

1. If you do not yet have the Citrix Receiver installed onto your computer, a popup box will appear. Check the Citrix license agreement checkbox and click Install.

As of right now you cannot access MHS Powerscribe on a non-MHS computer. They do not allow radiologist access to the Powerscribe portal at this time.
