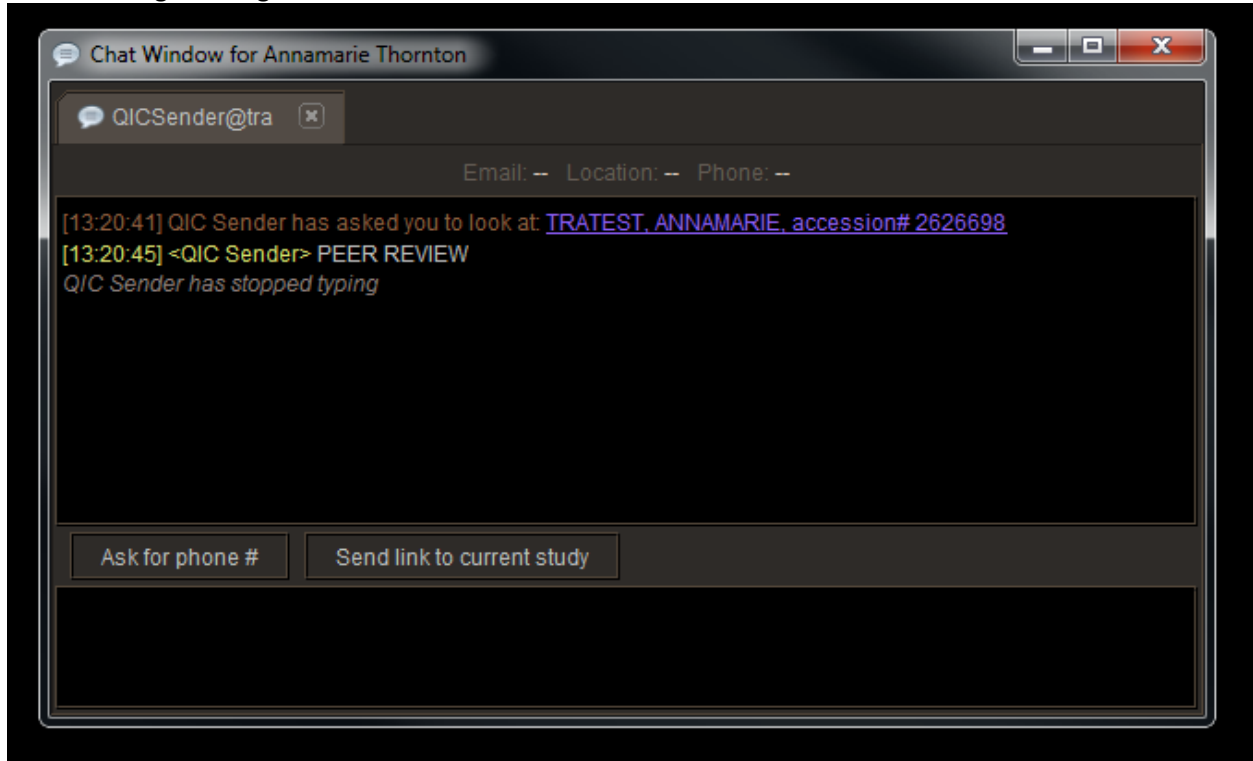


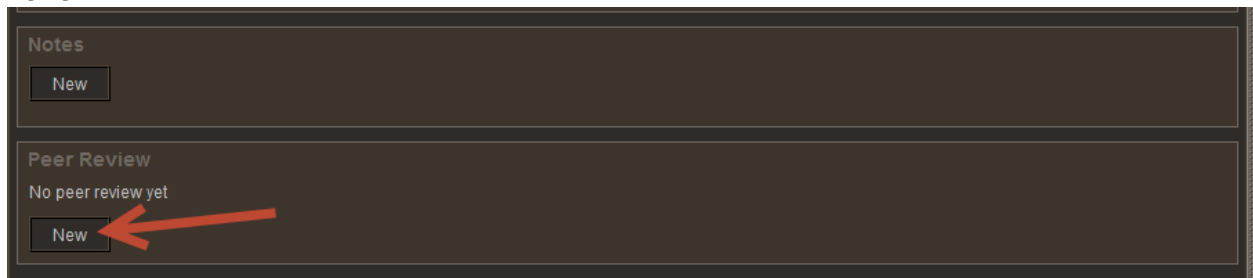
Peer Review

Click on the link to open the patient. Go to the patient history tab.

Scroll down past the report so you see the Peer Review box and click on the New button under Peer Review-
