Physician Report

EXAM: Digital Bilateral **Screening** Mammography

HISTORY: **Screening**. Patient has family history of breast cancer in her mother.

COMPARISON: 4/14/2014, 4/12/2013

Bilateral Digital screening mammogram with computer-aided detection

FINDINGS:

The breast parenchyma is comprised of scattered fibroglandular densities. Benign-appearing calcifications in the right breast are stable. No suspicious cluster of microcalcifications identified. No new mass or area of distortion identified. Areas of nodularity in both breasts are stable.

IMPRESSION:

BI-RADS 2, benign findings. Recommend routine screening in one year. The patients information was entered into a reminder system with a target due date for the next mammogram.

Breast Cyst - Case #2

Physician Report

BILATERAL WHOLE BREAST SONOGRAM

Clinical Indication: Abnormal mammography, **breast cyst**

Sonographic evaluation of the left breast, all 4 quadrants and retroareolar region demonstrates a benign 0.7 cm complex cyst at the 12:00 position 6 cm from the nipple. Sonographic evaluation of the right breast, all 4 quadrants and retroareolar region demonstrates dense echogenic fibrous breast tissue in the upper portion of the breast. No suspicious masses are noted in either breast.

Impression: IMPRESSION:

1. THERE IS PROBABLY BENIGN ASYMMETRIC DENSITY IN THE UPPER CENTRAL RIGHT BREAST. THERE IS A PROBABLY BENIGN 0.7 CM COMPLEX **CYST AT THE 12:00 POSITION IN THE LEFT BREAST.**
2. A FOLLOWUP BILATERAL MAMMOGRAM IN SIX MONTHS IS RECOMMENDED. THESE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS WERE DISCUSSED WITH THE PATIENT.

Abnormal Findings - Case # 3

Physician Report

Clinical History: Recall from screening mammography, abnormal mammography.

DIAGNOSTIC UNILATERAL RIGHT BREAST MAMMOGRAM WITH CAD:

Breast Composition Category (c): The breasts are heterogeneously dense, which may obscure small masses.

Findings: Multiple additional views of the right breast fail to demonstrate persistence of architectural distortion in the upper, outer quadrant.

Impression:

1. No mammographic or sonographic evidence of malignancy in the upper, outer quadrant of the right breast.

Plan: Routine screening mammography in one year is recommended unless otherwise clinically indicated.
