

Purpose

To provide an outline and description of the various tools in the ICD-10 Provider Education Series. These tools were designed to assist Client Service Managers in supporting their clients in making the transition to ICD-10.

The ICD-10 Provider Education Series has been developed for the specialties of: Radiology, Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine and Pathology. The series focuses on the most commonly used diagnoses and provider documentation requirements to provide the greatest level of specificity coding in ICD-10.

Tool	Description
ICD-10 Playbook	A PowerPoint presentation that outlines the Zotec Partners “playbook” for the ICD-10 transition. Includes a basic overview of ICD-10 and Zotec’s transition plans for four key areas: Technology, Coding, Providers and Payors.
ICD-10 Provider Documentation “101” Video	A 10-15 minute video that lays the foundation for the ICD-10 Provider Education Series. The 101 video explains the important concepts and changes within ICD-10 and how providers can prepare for a successful transition to ICD-10.
ICD-10 Quick Reference Guide (QRG)	A single-page document that provides the documentation requirements for the most frequently used diagnoses organized by major body areas (e.g., abdomen/pelvis, head, extremities) and major conditions (i.e., neoplasm, injuries, pregnancy). The QRG can be used as a reference sheet to ensure all documentation requirements are being included in a medical report.
ICD-10 Guidance Documents	A series of written documents for major body areas and major conditions that provide specific details of ICD-10 documentation requirements and provides examples that contrast unspecified vs. detailed documentation.
ICD-10 Guidance Videos	A series of 8-12 minute videos for major body areas and major conditions that provide specific details of ICD-10 documentation requirements and provides examples that contrast unspecified vs. detailed documentation.
ICD-10 Case Examples	A series of specific documentation case examples for the main diagnoses covered in the ICD-10 Guidance Documents and Videos (Rad and ED only).
ICD-10 Documentation Guidance Workbook	An Excel workbook that combines information from the ICD-10 Quick Reference Guide and ICD-10 Guidance Documents into a summary form. This format could be helpful in educating referring providers as well as be used to review/update documentation templates and/or macros.
